Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

**FROM THE NORTH WEST Nf:** Take Rt. 202 South, turn right onto Rt. 73 West, turn left onto Berks road to end, turn left to the farm on the left  
**FROM PHILA.:** Rt. 76 West to Plymouth Mfg. (Exit #28), getting on Rt. 476 to Germantown Pike West. Stay on the Germantown Pike and once you pass THROUGH the intersection of Rt. 202 THEN start counting nine more lights to turn right onto to end, turn left and make a quick right to the farm on the right  
**FROM KING OF PRUSSIA:** Take 422 West to the Trooper/Audubon exit, follow to the Germantown Pike turn right, next light Potshop Road turn left, follow to end, turn left and then a quick right to the farm on the right  
**FROM PA TPK:** Exit #333 for Norristown, follow signs for Plymouth Rd., left at light, go 300 yds to make right onto Germantown Pike West, follow to intersection of Rt. 202 THEN start counting nine more lights to make a right onto Potshop Rd., follow to end, make left and quick right to the farm on the right

Open to all juniors under 18 years of age who have not shown in more than eight horse shows in any one year. Riders may only cross enter into Short Stirrup or Pre-Children’s Hunter if eligible. Fences at 2’.

### CAMP/ACADEMY DIVISION

No USEF or USHJA Memberships required.

ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 per class

Open to all beginning riders who are part of a lesson or camp program. ASTM helmets and proper footwear required. Formal attire not required. Sections will be created if necessary, based on skill level and experience.

#### 33. Camp/Academy Walk Trot Equitation

Judged on the rider: Judged on hands, seat, general appearance and control of mount, showmanship and neatness. To be shown at the walk and trot.

#### 34. Camp/Academy Walk Trot Pleasure

Judged on the mount: Judged on manners and way of going at the walk and the trot, may be asked to halt.

#### 35. Camp/Academy Walk Trot, Ind. Canter Equitation

Judged on the rider: Judged on hands, seat, general appearance and control of mount, showmanship and neatness. To be shown at the walk and trot, with each rider performing an individual canter at the direction of the ring master.

#### 36. Camp/Academy Equitation Over poles

Judged on the rider: To show a posted course of four poles placed on the outside track of the arena. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance and control of mount, showmanship and neatness.

#### 37. EPPHA JUNIOR LOW EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to all Juniors on horses or ponies. Ponies to jump 2’, horses to jump 2’3”. Rider may not cross enter into a class over 2’6”, or have previously shown in any class over 2’6”. Course will consist of eight or more fences with or without wings. Course must contain at least one change of direction, and one roll back. Each course will include a simple test (USEF tests 1-8). Class will be judged on hands, seat, lets, guidance and control.

#### 38. EPPHA ADULT LOW EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to all adults amateur riders. Horses to jump 2’3”. Rider may not have shown or show in any class over 2’6”. Course and testing to be the same as the Junior Medal above.

#### 39. M&S CHILDREN'S MEDAL

ENTRY FEE: \$30.00

Horses 3', Large Ponies 2'6", Small/Medium Ponies 2'

#### 40. M&S CHILDREN'S HUNTER CLASSIC

ENTRY FEE: \$50.00

To be shown over a course of approximately 10 jumps. Children’s Hunter ponies to jump 2’6”, horses 3’. Top twelve horses/ponies to return for a second round. Full specifications and League Membership Forms available at the show office.

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Pre-entries can be made by mail, phone or Fax. Post entries will be accepted but pre-entries will be most appreciated.
2. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
3. The Our Farm Horse Shows, Our Group, Milestone Group, Worcester Stables, Inc., the Committee or property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
4. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
5. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
6. Ties for first place will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points, ribbons and prizemoney.
7. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds.
8. All pets must be leashed.
9. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
10. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non negotiable checks, checks will be collected according to USEF Rules.
11. Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but no limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooter, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they care accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
12. Should the veterinarian on call be needed to complete permanent measurement of horses or ponies, then the appointed time for said measurements will be 10:00 a.m. ALL ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEASUREMENTS MUST BE MADE IN ADVANCE THROUGH SHOW MANAGEMENT. All appointments must be set by the Wednesday before the competition. Phone (908)-534-8833 for information and procedures. Day measurements will of course be available at any time throughout the show day.
