RING & SCHOOLING INFORMATION

The indoor ring will be open from 6:30 a.m. only please. 10 minutes/\$10.00 per horse per session. The indoor ring footing is a rubber and sand mixture, and the performance area is approximately 220 ft. X 100 ft. The outdoor footing is a stonedust and sand mixture 200' X 80'.

ATTENTION EVERYONE!

If there are less than 6 horses entered in any section of a division offering prizemoney one-half hour before a section is to be run, a surcharge of \$25.00 per horse will apply.

ABOUT MEASUREMENTS....

Should the veterinarian need to be called to the show for the purpose of measuring horses or ponies, the appointed time will be 10:00 a.m. Saturday. Any and all necessary arrangements to have the veterinarian to the show for measurements must be made the Wednesday before each show, and must be made through the show office only. Permanent Measurements cannot be made on a walk-in basis but, of course, Day Measurements are always available at any time.

ABOUT STABLING....

Stalls are indoors...permanent...with doors. There are no refunds for unused stalls, and stalls must be paid for if reserved. RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Mail, phone, email and fax entries accepted until 9:00 pm the evening before the first day of the show. Any other entries must be made at the show.
2. Post entries will be accepted for an Office Fee of \$25.00 per horse at the Springfest Horse Show. Entries for the Regular Working and the Green Conformation Hunters must be made by April 2nd. No Post Entries will be accepted for these divisions. Post entries will be accepted at no additional charge at the Our Farm Horse Show on April 17th.
3. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted. Please read your entry blank carefully when signing, and follow all USEF Rules.
4. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
5. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
6. The Springfest Horse Show, the Our Farm Horse Show, Our Farm, Inc, Milestone Group, Our Group, Here & There Group, Worcester Stables Inc., the Committee, Briarwood Farm Inc., Katharine Benson or property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
7. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
8. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
9. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
10. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
11. Ties for first place will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points, ribbons and prizemoney.
12. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds according to USEF rules.
13. Prizemoney and Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office. Please allow one-half hour for processing.
14. All pets must be leashed.
15. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management by the steward.
16. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be forwarded to the USEF for collection per USEF Rules.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ATTN EXHIBITORS: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but no limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooter, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Five year olds and under suitable to become hunter ponies. Open to ponies registered with the PHSA and whose owners are current members. To be judged at a walk, trot and canter – not to jump. Conformation 50%; performance, soundness, manners and way of going, 50%. Two or more ponies than the number of ribbons awarded are to be stripped for conformation. Adult or Junior may ride.

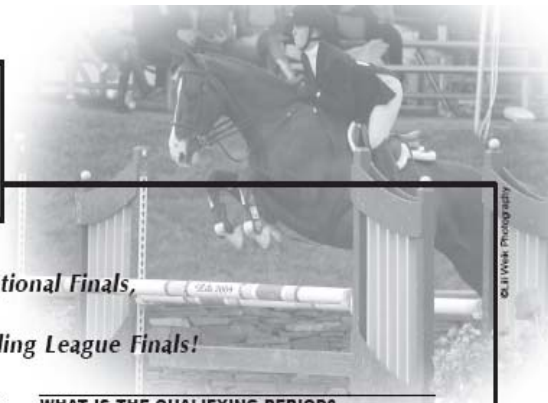
