Five year olds and under suitable to become hunters. Open to horses registered with the PHSA and who owners are current members. To be judged at a walk, trot and canter – not to jump. Conformation, 50%; performance, soundness, manners and way of going, 50%. Two more horses than the number of ribbons awarded are to be stripped for conformation.

Class 33 - **Young Hunter Pony Under Saddle:** PHSA Points only

Five year olds and under suitable to become hunter ponies. Open to ponies registered with the PHSA and whose owners are current members. To be judged at a walk, trot and canter – not to jump. Conformation 50%; performance, soundness, manners and way of going, 50%. Two or more ponies than the number of ribbons awarded are to be stripped for conformation. Adult or Junior may ride.

RING INFORMATION

The indoor ring footing is a rubber and sand mixture, and the performance area is approximately 220 ft. X 100 ft. The outdoor footing is a stonedust and sand mixture 200' X 80'. Additional areas designated for riding around the arenas are grass.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Post entries will be accepted, but early phone entries are most appreciated.
2. The ring will be open until 7:45 a.m. for schooling and at scheduled breaks: 10 minute sessions for \$10.00 paid on the entry. There will be a \$10.00 Grounds Fee on each entry.
3. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
4. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
5. The Keystone I and II HS, the Committee, Worcester Stables, Inc. Competition Management or the property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
6. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
7. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
8. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
9. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
10. Ties for first place will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points and ribbons.
12. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted.
13. Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office. Please allow one-half hour for processing. Prizemoney awarded at the gate.
13. All pets must be leashed.
14. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
15. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management by the steward.
16. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but no limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooter, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
17. Should the veterinarian on call be needed to complete permanent measurement of horses or ponies, then the appointed time for said measurements will be 10:00 a.m. ALL ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEASUREMENTS MUST BE MADE IN ADVANCE OF THE SHOW DAY THROUGH SHOW MANAGEMENT. Phone (908)-534-8833 for information and procedures. Day measurements will of course be available at any time throughout the show days.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
