

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

- PRE-ENTER AND SAVE! Pre-entries are just \$15 per class with no secretary's fee and must be received by 6 p.m. the day before the show. Entries made after 6 p.m. and on the day of the show are considered post entries and are **\$20 per class plus a \$10 secretary's fee.**
- Proof of negative Coggins test required for each entry.
- An EMT will be on site for all shows.
- Approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted.
- Workmanlike attire is acceptable (breeches, half-chaps).
- The ring will open for schooling at 7:30 a.m.
- Schooling breaks will be broken up into groups of no more than six horses. You may only participate in a schooling break if your division is next.
- No martingales may be worn in flat classes.
- A rider's age for the 2010 show year equals what was their age on December 1, 2009.
- Worcester Stables is not responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horses, ponies, pets, or property of any exhibitor or spectator on or off the show grounds.
- Management reserves the right to divide, combine, cancel divisions or classes, or change time schedule as necessary, and also reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Good sportsmanship and courtesy are expected from all exhibitors and spectators.
- The decisions of the judge and of show management are final.
- All dogs must be on leashes.

## CLASSES AND DIVISIONS:

**LEADLINE** – Open to riders 7 years of age and younger, who must be led by handlers who are adults. Riders may not cross enter into any other division.

1. Walk
2. Walk, Then Trot (Point-to-Point)
3. Walk Independently Without Leader

**WALK-TROT** – Open to riders of any age who are beginners on horses or ponies.

4. Walk-Trot Pleasure
5. Walk-Trot, Then Trot a Figure 8 From Lineup
6. Walk-Trot Bridle Path Hack (The judge may call for the halt)
7. Walk-Trot Groundrails (4, counter clockwise)

**PLEASURE HORSE/PONY** – Open to horses and ponies.

8. Pleasure Horse/Pony Walk-Trot
9. Pleasure Horse/Pony Walk-Trot-Canter
10. Pleasure Horse/Pony Bridle Path Hack (may be asked to halt)
11. Pleasure Horse/Pony Walt-Trot-Canter/2 Crossrails From Lineup

**SHORT STIRRUP** – Open to riders 12 and younger.

12. Short Stirrup Walt-Trot
13. Short Stirrup Walt-Trot-Canter
14. Short Stirrup Walt-Trot-Canter, Then Jump 2 Crossrails From Lineup
15. Short Stirrup Canter Course of Four Crossrails

**LONG STIRRUP** – Open to riders 13 years and older. If entries warrant, this division will be split into junior and adult divisions.

16. Long Stirrup Walt-Trot
17. Long Stirrup Walt-Trot-Canter
18. Long Stirrup Walt-Trot-Canter/2 Crossrails From Lineup
19. Long Stirrup Canter Course of Four Crossrails

**BEGINNER EQUITATION** – Open to junior and adult riders in their first year of showing. To be judged on the rider's position, safety, and control of mount. Fences set at 2'.

20. Beginner Equitation Walt-Trot
21. Beginner Equitation Walt-Trot-Canter
22. Beginner Equitation Walt-Trot-Canter/2 Crossrails From Lineup
23. Beginner Equitation Over Fences

**CROSSRAILS HUNTER DIVISION** – Open to all horses and ponies. Crossrails not to exceed 2' at the center of the x. Simple changes in corners not penalized.

24. Crossrails Hunter Over Fences
25. Crossrails Hunter Over Fences
26. Crossrails Hunter Over Fences
27. Crossrails Hunter Under Saddle

**SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION(S)** – Open to horses and ponies. Should entries warrant, each height will be split into its own division, or any two heights may be combined. Combined divisions will be run on an open card (all 2' trips, then all 2'6" trips, then all 2'9" trips).

29. Schooling Hunter Over Fences
30. Schooling Hunter Under Saddle

**SCHOOLING JUMPER DIVISION** – Open adults and juniors on horses or ponies.

31. Faults converted into seconds 2'3"
32. Faults converted into seconds 2'6"
33. Faults converted into seconds 2'9"
34. **WORCESTER STABLES GAMBLER'S CHOICE** – Open to adults and juniors on horses or ponies. Fences set at 2'3", 2'6", 2'9" and 3' (no combinations) and with points assigned for every jump. Knock-downs result in no points accumulated for that particular jump. Participants may only jump each obstacle twice, within the time allowed.
